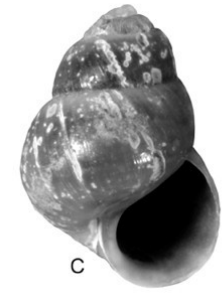

Classrooms

- It's very important to keep invasive creatures out of classrooms
- Never bring invasive plants or animals inside classroom
- If necessary, you must kill invasive species that are in classes
- You Can Do This With Things Like:
 - Herbicides
 - Other Poisons
 - Drying Out
 - Etc.



- Precautions must Always Be Taken on Field Trips
- To Prevent The Spread of Invasive Species
 - Always Wash Everything
 - Wash Buses, Shoes, Socks
 - Make sure all samples collected are killed before disposed of.
 - Brush seeds off pants and shoes before entering vehicle
 - Clean Under Part of Vehicle Thoroughly
 - Limit amount of samples students take from environment
